At Little Lambs Preschool, we believe in providing a warm, caring, educational and fun environment for each child. Our 3 year old classes aim to help each child learn skills necessary for future success in developmentally appropriate ways. Our small teacher/child ratio (1:6) allows children to have more interaction and personal help and support.

Our 3 year old program is designed for socialization and intro to school. Children are encouraged to share, take turns, respect others and materials, and to follow directions and classroom rules. Teachers provide them the tools to problem solve on their own and allow them to express themselves through language, play and art experiences. Play allows children to explore their world and to learn in many immersive ways 😊

A typical 3 year old day starts with free play and our teachers insure their day gets off to a great start. Their day will include:

- Gathering Time - theme of the day, talk about activity / project
- Small group Art or Activity project for the day
- Play areas - large motor, block, housekeeping, art, small motor, +more
- Rug Time - group discussion on calendar, weather, themed story, "Show & Tell Bag" and "Me Box". This gives children an understanding about how to take turns, build self confidence, and increase language skills.
- Clean Up Time - all are expected to help and work together
- Snack Time with a short prayer and focus on good manners
- End of Day song, dance and/or large motor group activity

At the end of our day, the lead teacher goes in the hallway to discuss with parents the happenings from the day and any possible announcements. Meanwhile, the children and other teachers are singing the "Good-bye Song". Parents are asked to sign their child out, allowing the teacher to use this for dismissal of class. Any art work or notes to go home will be on the tables with the child's name on it 😊
