Monday, Wednesday, & Friday P.M. 12:30 to 3:30

***At Little Lambs Preschool, we believe in providing a warm, caring, educational and fun environment for each child. Our 4 year old classes aim to help each child learn skills necessary for future success in developmentally appropriate ways. Our small teacher/child ratio (1:6) allows children to have more interaction and personal help and support.***

A typical 4 year old day: Your child will visit both our large and small classrooms.

The "large room" is used to .....

- \*teach about the theme
- \*introduce the corresponding project &/or activity
- \*free choice play
- \*snack
- \*any large motor group activities

The "small room" is used for .....

- \*quieter activities and academic "work"
- \*Rug Time: Calendar Weather, Count the days attended, Introduce & discuss academics, and read stories
- \*Practice Academic skills such as writing their name, colors, shapes, patterning, numbers & letters!

Your child will move through the building with their individual groups and teachers (assigned to you in September)...from large room to small room and vice versa. Example... If you drop off your child in the small room in the morning, your child will spend about 1 1/2 hours with their 12 classmates and 2 teachers. They will then move to the big room for the remainder of the time.... joining the other small class of 12 students & 2 teachers, making 24 students & 4 teachers in the large room. They will be dropped off & picked up in the same spot!

The 3 day a week program provides students with all the opportunities and teachings needed. However, the 5 day program gives students extra enhancements and enrichments of the week's theme and academic teachings. It provides a more consistent schedule of coming each day. It is a bigger step towards their success with their kindergarten schedule the following year.
